

Junior Project Manager/Project Manager

Job Description and Responsibilities

The Junior Project Manager has a range of responsibilities that include assisting the bioinformatics and project teams, interacting with clients and drafting reports and project updates, conducting scientific research, as well as applicable manuscript and/or paper writing. These duties are all related to the development of vaccines and therapeutic proteins.

The Jr. Project Manager:

- Serves as a primary client contact and keeps internal teams updated on action items/progress updates;
- Ensures projects are completed on time and within budget;
- Drafts summaries and final reports for corporate clients;
- Documents data validation, quality control and formatting procedures;
- Performs data analysis using GraphPad Prism and Microsoft Excel;
- Communicates experimental data effectively and regularly to others during project meetings and scientific reviews;
- Assists with producing grant applications and in performing literature reviews, writing, preparing, and editing scientific manuscripts for submission;
- Constructs abstracts and scientific posters for conferences;
- Coordinates tasks with Bioinformatics team and Project teams as necessary;
- Keeps current on applicable scientific literature;
- Performs related duties and responsibilities as required.

Qualifications

Required:

- 1-3 years professional, related experience;
- B.A. or B.S. in Biology, Microbiology, Immunology, Biochemistry, Mathematics or equivalent;
- Basic knowledge in the areas of microbiology, immunology, biochemistry, and statistics;
- Analytical skills to participate in developing research protocols, perform statistical analyses, and participate in qualitative/quantitative analyses of research data;
- Strong written and verbal communication skills including presentation of data;
- Strong knowledge of and experience with MS Office.
- Experience using online research tools such as PubMed and GenBank;

Preferred:

- Experience developing and producing grant applications and/or peer reviewed scientific papers;
- Clinical or technical research experience, including data collection and entry into a computer system;
- Experience with statistical and math related software such as GraphPad Prism and SigmaPlot.
